TERMS OF USE

By obtaining this permit you are agreeing to abide by Memorial University's Parking and Traffic Regulations. www.mun.ca/cep/parking/Traffic and Parking 2014.pdf.

The following are key terms of use of the carpool permit:

- Three or more students may apply for a single permit at the appropriate fee for use in a carpool.
- To qualify for a carpool parking permit, students must have a minimum of 48 credit hours from Memorial University. This applies to all individuals carpooling under one permit.
- Only one vehicle is permitted to be parked in the designate parking area at a time.
- A permit holder shall only park in the designated carpool parking space as indicated on the permit, and not park in an area for which they don't have a permit.

- Parking administration must be notified immediately of any change in the status of the carpool group. If a carpool member drops out, the remaining members will have 30 days to recruit a new member. If a new member is not found, the carpool is disbanded.
- It is considered a violation of the Parking and Traffic Regulations to give another individual your permit. You must return the permit to the parking office. A refund will be calculated at the time the permit is returned. Section 30.
- Any vehicle that is observed not to be complying with carpool permit rules will be subject to ticketing and/or towing. Misuse of the program, or giving false information, may result in revocation loss of all permit parking privileges at Memorial.
- Normal parking fees apply and will be divided amongst carpool members. For example, in lot 16A the fee is \$24 per term, thus with four people carpooling it would cost \$6 each.
- Participants may be a member of one carpool group only, unless there are unique or extenuating circumstances.
- A student can only hold one parking permit (i.e., individual daytime parking OR carpool parking).
