Memorial University of Newfoundland's Faculty of Education is searching for an Associate Dean of Undergraduate Programs. The Associate Dean will play a leadership role in advancing teacher education at Memorial University, ensuring that it is at the forefront of the profession, and that it is meeting the changing needs of the local, provincial, national, and global society. The successful applicant will have excellent organizational and communication skills, be innovative and be able to foster in others energy, creativity, enthusiasm, and a desire to succeed. As a member of the leadership team who reports to the Dean of Education, the Associate Dean will share responsibility for the overall management of the Faculty and will encourage the development of new and innovative academic programs that will contribute to the growth of Memorial University. The Associate Dean will support teaching and learning excellence at all levels and will nurture an environment conducive to faculty and student research.

The Associate Dean works with full-time, contractual and sessional faculty members and staff to sustain a collegial environment that values divergent perspectives and practices. Also, s/he liaises and works with other faculties and administrations to ensure that the Faculty of Education's strategic priorities remain visible within the greater University community and are aligned with the objectives of the University's strategic plans and the Comprehensive Framework for Teaching and Learning. The ability to collaborate with the broader University community and other external organizations including government, professional organizations, schools and school districts is also essential.

The candidate must have a doctorate in Education or a related discipline and possess a teaching and scholarship/research track record consistent with the level of associate or full professor. The candidate will have experience in the education system and be familiar with provincial post-secondary programs. Administrative experience within a university or in other settings applicable to teacher education, as well as experience in positions involving external relationship building, would be considered an asset.
