Zhejiang Gongshang University in China – Spoken English Promotion Project

In order to help students to improve their competitive abilities in job-seeking and future professional development, the University launched the Spoken English Promotion Project (SEPP) in 2001.

In 2006, ZJGSU decided to invite more international students in groups from various countries to take part in the SEPP by providing strong financial support. Each qualified international student is assigned to chat in English with ZJGSU students for 3 hours per workday during their stay at ZJGSU.

The financial support provides international students with:

- FREE local transportation in Hangzhou
- FREE local sightseeing during weekends in Hangzhou
- FREE food and accommodation on campus in ZJGSU
- FREE 2-hour classes in Chinese language and culture or business in the morning

The activities of international students in SEPP include:

- Chatting with ZJGSU students in English
- Having classes of Chinese language and culture or business
- Sightseeing on weekends

Zhejiang Gongshang University will cover all the expenses related to Hangzhou International Airport/bus/train station pick-up, the Chinese culture and language/business course, food, twin-bed room accommodation. ZJGSU issues the Certificate of SEPP and the Certificate of Chinese Language and Culture/ Business to the students and faculty members of SEPP delegation at the conclusion of SEPP.

The students and faculty members selected by the partner university for the SEPP must speak standard and fluent English with an active, vibrant, sociable, and articulate personality and they have to be screened and confirmed by ZJGSU through an interview on MSN or Skype.

Irish Scholarships: all awards to Irish scholars are for **€5,000**, with the exception of the 2 Atlantic Corridor Scholarships (for scholars affiliated to Athlone Institute of Technology) which are for **€2,500** each.
