RSO made suggestion to revise the current requirement to clean and re-wipe areas with wipe test results of 2x background or more to a more consistent value of 0.5 Bg/cm². Deferred to Tier It committee members in attendance were in favor of the revision but Tier I meeting recommended it be tabled at the next Tier I meeting for full approval. Contamination action limit RSO made suggestion to revise the current "action limit" for removable contamination of 0.5 Bq/cm² to a more effective and appropriate "action" indicator. RSO suggested this value be in the range of 50-100 Bq/cm² for Class A isotopes) Tier II committee members in attendance were in favor of the revision but Deferred to recommended it be tabled at the next Tier I meeting for full approval. Tier i meeting **URSC** committee meeting frequency RSO made a suggestion to reduce meeting requirements from four (4) to three (3)/year (one (1) of which to be Tier I).
