HKR 2002	Coaching	Full Course	1 evening time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Recreation, Education or a related area is preferred) Certified Level 3 coach in NCCP. 5 years experience coaching.
HKR 3210	Physical Activities Course: Court Games	1/6 of unit(12 hours) - Volleyball	1 day time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Kinesiology, Education or a related area is preferred) A minimum of two years professional experience in providing instruction using a conceptual approach to volleyball. Coaching certification would be an asset.

HKR 3210	Physical Activities Course: Court Games	1/4 of unit (18 hours) - Track and Field	1 day time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Kinesiology, Education or a related area is preferred). A minimum of two years professional experience in providing instruction using a conceptual approach to track and field. Coaching certification would be an asset.
HKR 3220	Physical Activities Course: Target and Field Games	1/5 of unit (15 hours) - Canoeing	1 day time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Kinesiology, Education or a related area is preferred). Competence and experience in teaching both of those as well as experience in leading groups on trips of at least three-day duration. Certification in Paddle Canada instructor levels: Canoe tripping instructor and canoe instructor intermediate tandem.

HKR 3535	Legal aspects of Leisure and Recreation Services	Full Course	1 evening time section; St. John's Campus	L.L.B. with a minimum of 2 years of related legal work experience Demonstrated knowledge of key course concepts including legal issues related to the operation of leisure services and facilities.
HKR 4220	Physical Activities Course: Territorial Games 2	1/6 of unit (12 hours) - Ultimate Frisbee	1 day time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Kinesiology, Education or a related area is preferred). A minimum of two years professional experience in providing instruction using a conceptual approach to ultimate frisbee. Coaching certification would be an asset.

HKR 4220	Physical Activities Course: Territorial Games 2	1/6 of unit (12 hours) Rugby	1 day time section; St. John's Campus	Bachelor's degree (a specialization in Physical Education, Kinesiology, Education or a related area is preferred). A minimum of two years professional experience in providing instruction using a conceptual approach to rugby. Coaching certification would be an asset.

HKR 2601	Physical Activity, Obesity, and Weight Control	Full Course	Distance via World Wide Web	M.P.E., M.SC. (KIN), or an undergraduate degree and 10 years equivalent experience with a background in obesity and the effects on society.
