Procedure for Institutional Signature – Tri-Agency Operating Grants

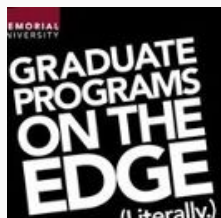

SGS will provide additional instructions on this process closer to that date. SGS will continue to accept paper copies of theses under the existing submission procedures up to Nov. 1, 2013, but any student wishing to submit a final electronic copy before that date may certainly do so.
