Spirit Competition Team Rules and Regulations:

Team Composition:

1. A team can be comprised of any collection of students, staff, or faculty* of Memorial University, including, but not limited to:
 - a. Undergraduate, graduate, on-campus or off-campus students, staff or faculty (ex. 2 graduate students living off campus, 1 undergraduate student living in residence, 2 staff members).
2. Each team will include a minimum of 5 people up to a maximum of 15 people.
3. Each student, staff, or faculty member can only be registered as a participant on one team.
4. Teams will be submitted first come, first served. No team name can be used twice.

Team Registration:

5. A list of all team members and a team name must be submitted through online registration starting October 5th, 2011.
6. By submitting a team and team name, you are agreeing to abide by the rules and regulations of the spirit competition. See list of violations for more details.
7. All registered team members have rights to equal share of any or all prize winnings.*
*Memorial University will not be responsible for mediation or disputes between team members regarding the distribution of prize winnings.

Team Rules:

8. All team members are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all time during the competition according to the Code of Student Conduct.
9. A team must respect the property of Memorial University, including, but not limited to, trespassing, damage of property and classroom disruptions.
10. All submissions for the spirit competition must be made by the close of I Love MUNdays, 12 noon, Tuesday, October 25, 2011.
11. A bonus clue will be available on the MUNdays website at 12 noon everyday from October 20-October 24, 2011. The bonus clues will only be posted online for one hour, and if completed, a team will be given additional credit in the spirit competition. The team must complete the bonus and email the submission to mundays@mun.ca before 11:59 p.m. on the day the clue is released to receive credit.
12. By registering a team the participants authorize Memorial University and/or their delegates to use these images/videos. They may use this material in any format, with intentional or unintentional alterations, and use for the purpose of illustration, publicity, advertising, promotion, recruitment, and/or publication of any product or service for the university for any period of time.
13. Each team must designate one member of their team as a team captain. The team captain will be responsible for administering/posting all of the social media content that is required in the challenges.
