While these courses may be repeated from courses used to satisfy the requirements in Section I above, you are reminded of the restriction that no more than 9 credit hours in courses from any one discipline can be used to satisfy the BA Core requirements. In this regard, please note the following when selecting courses to meet this particular core requirement:

- No more than 3 credit hours from English courses can be used toward meeting this requirement;
- No more than 3 credit hours in the subject area that was used to satisfy the language requirement can be used towards meeting this requirement.

The following is a summary of noteworthy requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree extracted from both the General Academic Regulations (Undergraduate) and the Faculty of Arts regulations in the 2014-2015 University Calendar. It is not representative of all regulations under which a student may be governed. Please consult the University Calendar for further information. - You must successfully complete a minimum of 120 credit hours applicable to the degree and consisting of the following components:
- Core Requirements - students are strongly advised to complete the Core Requirements within the first 60 credit hours of their program
- First Major - students must complete an approved Major of between 36 and 45 credit hours depending on the major you choose. Up to 9 credit hours used to satisfy the Core Requirements can also be used toward the Major;
- Either, a Second Major or a Minor - you must complete either, the required number of credit hours for a second Major (between 36 and 45 credit hours depending on the discipline you choose); Or, the required number of credit hours for a Minor (minimum of 24 credit hours). Up to 9 credit hours used to satisfy the Core Requirements can also be used toward the second Major or Minor.
- You cannot complete both an interdisciplinary first Major and an interdisciplinary second Major or Minor.
- Unless otherwise stated in the program regulations, no course can be used to satisfy both the requirements for a Major and the requirements for a second Major or Minor.
- You must achieve an average of $60 \%$ or higher on the minimum number of courses prescribed for each of the Major and the Minor, excluding 1000-level courses.
- Including the courses used to satisfy the Core Requirements, the major and the minor, you must complete a total of 78 of the 120 credit hours required for the degree in courses offered by departments within the Faculty of Arts. You must achieve an overall average of 2.0 points or higher per credit hour on these courses.
- The remaining 42 credit hours (for a total of 120 credit hours required for the degree) will be electives; these may be chosen from offerings in Arts, Science, Business and Music (Musicologies and Music Theory and Composition only). Up to 15 of these elective credit hours may be in any subject area, with the exception of courses which are clearly practical or professional:
- Outdoor Pursuits or Expeditions in Environmental Studies
- Internships, Student Teaching or Practicum in Education
- Activity and Coaching courses in Human Kinetics and Recreation
- Applied Music or Ensemble Techniques in Music
- Nursing Practice or Clinical Practicum in Nursing
- Clinical Clerkship in Pharmacy
- Field Placements in Social Work
- Master Classes in Fine Arts (Theatre)
- Studio Courses in Fine Arts (Visual)
- You must obtain an average of at least 2.0 points on the total number of credit hours required for the degree.
- If you have previously completed or are currently completing another undergraduate degree from this University, please note that in addition to satisfying the separate requirements of each degree, you must also complete, at this University, a minimum of $\mathbf{3 0}$ credit hours beyond those required for the first degree which are applicable to the additional degree being sought.
- You must complete at this University the last 30 credit hours required for your degree.
- You must complete at least 24 credit hours through attendance at classes on the campus of a recognized university or university college. Distance education courses cannot be used to satisfy this requirement.


## Additional Notes:

- Students are strongly encouraged to request an academic audit after they have completed 60 credit hours. Audits can be requested through the Office of the Registrar
