



ISWEP AGREEMENT FORM - WINTER 2021 (International Student Work Experience Program)

I AGREE THAT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS CORRECT:

I am a full-time international undergraduate student registered in at least three credit courses* during the semester or I am doing a reduced course load as an accommodation through the Blundon Centre in accordance with the Accessibility for Students with Disabilities Policy. (If the student drops a course and is therefore taking less than three credit courses, they are no longer eligible for an ISWEP position.)

I have a 60% or above cumulative average or a 60% or above average in the last ten courses or have an average below 60%, and am applying with support through the Blundon Centre in accordance with the Accessibility for Students with Disabilities Policy. (First year students have attained a 60% cumulative average because of the admission average.)

I will not work more than 80 ISWEP hours in a semester, or 80 hours of combined ISWEP and MUCEP positions.

I am not on a work term during the semester in which the ISWEP application is submitted.

***Spring – one course registration is required.**

I understand that the above conditions must be adhered to in order to be eligible for an ISWEP position this semester.
