He served as Director of Economic Studies and Policy Analysis in the Department of Finance from 1997 to 1998 and, from 2003 to 2004, as Associate Assistant Deputy Minister and then Acting Assistant Deputy Minister for the Energy Sector of Natural Resources Canada (NRCan). Dr. Plourde was the EPCOR Professor of Energy Policy in the School of Business at the University of Alberta. He has an impressive record of awards, research grants, contracts and expert consultancies primarily in the area of resource economics focused on energy, power and oil.
