

EVER GREEN RECYCLING - Information for WAMUN as of July 22, 2011

On July 22, 2011 a new account was set up for WAMUN members and registered under the Recycling Card Program with Ever Green.

This new program replaces the former system whereby our members simply walked in and said, "Credit these recyclables to the WAMUN account". Verbal directives are no longer sufficient.

Under the new Recycling Card Program, a customer receives a card, similar to a credit card, which is used as follows:

In the "Recycling Card Area" of the depot, the customer swipes the card, enters the number of bags being dropped off, and the machine prints out bar-coded stickers which are affixed to the bags. The bags are then deposited into the storage container and the customer may depart. Once the recyclables have been calculated, an email notification verifies what has been counted and deposited into the customer's account.

At the present time, our account name is: **WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF MUN**. But, we do not have individual cards for each WAMUN member; quite simply, our annual volume of recyclables is not sufficient to warrant linking over 80 cards to the account.

However, to accommodate our members' desires to continue recycling through Ever Green, we will be permitted to drop off bags of recyclables without using an account card as long as an identifying label is taped to the bag.

The label must read: **WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF MUN** and must be securely taped. Once there is evidence of a larger volume of activity on our account, additional cards may be issued.

HOW TO PROPERLY PREPARE YOUR RECYCLABLES

A simple way to describe what will be accepted for recycling is to say that Ever Green accepts anything that you drink from: cans, bottles, plastic bottles, gable-top juice boxes, but NOT milk cartons.

DO NOT crush cans.

DO ENSURE that bottles are not broken

DO REMOVE caps, straws, and other garbage

DO NOT REMOVE LABELS (labels are required in order to identify the contents)

DO EMPTY all the liquid (a container is considered contaminated if it contains liquids, straws, etc.)
