1	Start with the Abstract
	Begin by reading the abstract to quickly understand the article's main objectives, methods, results, and conclusions.
2	Scan Introduction and Conclusion:
	Get an overview of the study by skimming the introduction for background and the conclusion for key findings.
3	Analyze Figures and Tables
	Focus on visual representations like figures and tables to better understand the data and results presented in the article.
4	Review Methods and Results
	Explore the methods section to understand how the study was conducted, and then examine the results section for detailed findings.
5	Check References
	Look at the references to identify related research and assess the article's influence in the field based on its citations.
