It takes about quarter of an hour by car from Rocky Harbour so it is a good idea to rent a car upon your arrival to the airport of Deer Lake. Please do all your reservations well in advance, this is a hot tourist season!

The airport of Deer Lake (YDL) is 65 km away from Norris Point. Please click here

For this, we ask you to provide us with your flight itinerary by email at aac@mun.ca as soon as you have your tickets (please have them soon!). We will write you if we are able to meet you at the airport. Otherwise, you will need to take taxi to Norris Point, Bonne Bay Marine Station. The price is about \$75. It is better if you call the taxi company at least 24 hours in advance. You can see the telephone numbers at the reference in the previous paragraph, in particular, Pittman's Taxi 458-2486 (Norris Point), Glover Humber 458-8186(Norris Point), Star Taxi 635-2521 (Deer Lake)

The registration will be organized on Saturday night during the welcome party and on Monday, at 9 am, both at BBMS. Some fees to be collected include a registration fee to cover our expenses for the preparation of the conference and also some meals at the station, during our regular working days, which are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, including coffee breaks and lunches, delivered to us by local restaurants. If you plan to join us on Wednesday, August 19 for a boat tour to West Brook Pond (a former fiord, now separated from the ocean), you will be asked to purchase your admission during the registration. On the same night, Wednesday, August 19, we plan to have a conference dinner in Black Spruce Restaurant at Neddie Harbor Inn. You will be able to make your choice of dishes on Monday. Please bring enough cash with you because this is how you will be asked to pay during the registration and probably with some smaller vendors. ATM's are available around Norris Point and Rocky Harbour but often set to a \$200.00 withdrawal limit. We will write you well in advance to inform you about the exact amounts of all the above charges.

Please be very careful with driving in the area during dark hours because there are many moose wandering in the woods and across the roads.
