Dear Friends,

This is to answer some of your possible questions.

1. When you arrive at St. John's airport, there is a person from Citywide Taxi company whom you should tell to what hotel you want to go. He will tell you the price and assign you to a taxi.
2. On September 2 we organize delivering people by taxi from The Roses Bed & Breakfast on Military Road 9 near The Roses. The taxis will leave at 8:45. You could also walk and at the end of this message you will find the references to the maps. An average walk is 40 minutes.
3. When you arrive at the campus of Memorial University please proceed to Mathematics Building which is also called Henrietta Harvey Building (HH-building). The room of the Atlantic Algebra Centre is HH-2010. From 9 - 9:20 am you will be given workshop kits and asked to pay a small registration fee \$25 to cover our coffee breaks, printing expenses, etc.
4. The first lecture begins at 9:30 am on September 2 in Arts and Administration building across the yard from Mathematics. We attach the schedule of the workshop to this message.
5. We have the following equipment for the talks: computer projector, projector from the transparencies and plain paper, and also chalk board. Everyone is getting an Internet account using desktop computers in the Computer lab on the third floor of HH-building. You will be able to use Maple and MathLab. We could try to organize the wireless and those who are in need must indicate this in their messages very soon.

6. After the first day there will be a wine and cheese get-together in Yuri Bahturin's house at 40 Rumboldt Place from 6 – 8 pm.
7. There will be a workshop dinner on Monday September 5. We do not fix menu so that you could choose yourself. The price could be within \$25 – \$50, depending on your appetite. Having cash makes it easier. You will also need cash for lunches, entertainment, etc.
8. There will be a day off during the workshop (we plan Sunday, September 4). There are several options how to spend it.
 - (a) We could book a boat tour from Bay Bulls to watch puffins and whales. The web site of the provider <http://www.gatheralls.com> The Adult price is \$59, the Student price is \$36, provided that you are 25 years old and under (student ID required). Shuttle from downtown St. John's to Bay Bulls and back is \$25 per person. This money will be paid individually on the spot. But we need to know the number of those who are willing to attend no later than August 29.
 - (b) Those who are not willing to go by boat to watch puffins can take local boat tours from St. John's Harbour, e.g. <http://icebergquest.com/rates-schedules/> (\$55), <http://www.deejaycharters.ca/> (\$50 + \$5 for screech-in).
 - (c) Go hiking. We have many walking trails (please have good shoes, etc.) and that we will be ready to help.
 - (d) Other attractions include Aquarena (swimming pool and gym), Wallnuts (wall climbing), etc.

The weather in St. John's can be very different so equip yourself accordingly!
