Final Announcement

The Workshop will run from Monday, August 11, to Friday, August 15, 2025. Wednesday afternoon will be devoted to open discussions and sightseeing in Gros Morne National Park. The venue is Bonne Bay Aquarium and Research Station of Memorial University in Norris Point, NL. All talks will be given in the lecture theater of the Station. The options are a computer projector (preferred method) and a white board with dry-erase markers. If you are giving a talk and have not sent us the title and abstract yet, please do so as soon as possible (aac@mun.ca). A tentative schedule will be available shortly.

The arrival day is Sunday, August 10, and the departure day is Saturday, August 16. If we reserved a room for you at the Station, these are your check-in and check-out dates, and you will be receiving instructions from the Station Manager shortly. If you need to check in a day earlier or check out a day later, please discuss this with the Station Manager.

Most of you will arrive to Deer Lake Airport (YDF). The distance from the airport to the Station is approximately 75 km. We will try to arrange rides or shared taxis, for which we will need your arrival time. To collect this and other information (such as dietary restrictions, accompanying persons), we ask you to fill out the following form:

There are limited dining options in Norris Point, but we should have enough cars in our group to arrange rides to Rocky Harbour, which has several restaurants.
