The International Workshop “Groups and Hopf Algebras” will take place at Memorial University of Newfoundland on June 3–5, 2009, followed by the Summer CMS Meeting at Memorial University on June 6–8, 2009. The CMS Meeting will include a special session “Groups and Hopf Algebras” on June 6–7.

The main topics are two areas with close interaction: Group Rings and Hopf Algebras. On June 3–5, we will have for each topic a total of six hours of lectures delivered by:

In addition to the lectures, there will be a number of 40-minute talks on June 3–5 and then 20-minute talks on June 6–7, in the framework of the CMS Special Session. The plenary speaker representing the session is Susan Montgomery (University of Southern California, USA).
