

BIOLOGY AT HARLOW (Majors Courses)

WHEN: Spring Semester

- Each course will run for two (2) weeks; students should be prepared to do preparatory work for the courses and allocate time post-Harlow for the write-up of projects and reports.

COURSES:

BIOL 4910 Vertebrate Diversity and Adaptation

BIOL 4911 Field course in Applied Biology

- Due to the limited number of places available the department may preferentially accommodate qualified students wishing to take both courses.
- **STUDENTS SHOULD NOT OBTAIN PLANE TICKETS UNTIL ADVISED TO DO SO.**

COSTS: Student will be personally responsible for purchasing the air-plane ticket but should not do so until advised by the department. Currently, tickets from St. John's to London Heathrow are approximately \$1000.00. There will also be an additional program fee for each course, to be paid during registration (\$CAD).

Accommodation fees (shared room) at Harlow per person/week are approximately GBP \$127.75 – \$138.95 (depending on room size).
