Focus area: Supply chain and operations management

Supply chain and operations management are critical aspects of business in diverse fields such as technology, oil and gas, healthcare and more. Pursuing courses from this focus area will help you gain confidence in framing supply chain and logistics challenges. It will also empower you to use analytics to derive effective and efficient managerial decisions that are values-based and sustainable.
