HONORARY DEGREES

G. JEAN CRANE

G. Jean Crane was born in 1929 and grew up in what is now called Sheshatshiu, Labrador.

An Inuit Elder, artist, healer, drummer, and community advocate, Elder Crane grew up at the intersection of Innu and Inuit culture, and carries with her deep ancestral and land knowledges from both cultures.

She is a prolific painter, rug hooker, knitter and sewer, has worked with health professionals on integrating traditional medicine into Western healing practices, and been a life-long advocate for women's rights and safety.

She is frequently asked to offer prayers, perform ceremonies and to share her wisdom locally, regionally, and nationally, including during the Prime Minister's 2017 apology to survivors of Newfoundland and Labrador's residential schools.

Elder Crane was an advisor for Memorial's Inuit bachelor of education and Inuit bachelor of social work degree programs, was a member of the Board of Regents, and is an advisor for the development of a Labrador Campus.



NELLIE MAY WINTERS

Nellie May Winters was born in 1938 in Okak Bay, on the North Coast of Labrador in what is today the self-governing Inuit region of Nunatsiavut.

With a portfolio spanning eight decades, Elder Winters stands out as a generational talent for her technical mastery of traditional Inuit art forms and for her unceasing artistic innovation.

She is a preeminent garment designer and seamstress and is well-known for her startlingly real Inuit dolls. Her long list of works includes caribou tufting, grasswork, caps, dresses, beadwork, bone jewelry, carvings, wall hangings, purses, and paintings.

Her work has been commissioned and exhibited by galleries, museums, and private collections across Canada and internationally.

Elder Winters has taught crafts and life skills in Makkovik and was also a long-time interpreter for Labrador-Grenfell Health. Her memoir, *Reflections from Them Days: A Residential School Memoir from Nunatsiavut*, is illustrated with her original artwork. She also published *The Christmas Drop*, illustrated by her granddaughter.

Nellie May Winters inolisimajuk 1938-imi Okak kangitlungani, Taggaup Satjugiangani Labradorimi ullumiulittuk tainna namminik kavamagijaulittumut Inuit NunakKatigengitumut Nunatsiavummi.

Ilitagijautsiatluni pisimajumit âttanit senaguttittisimajunut, InutuKak Winters takutsausiavuk kinguvânik pitsiasongunnimminik piusiKatsiatluni ilisimatsiatlunillu piusituKannik Inuit allanguattauKattajunut ammalu Kanutsuatuinnak sunatuinnanillu sanguatiutluni isumaKatsiatlunillu allanguasongugiamut sananguasongugiamullu.
