The S.P. Raheja Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship was established through generous gifts from the friends and family members of S. P. Raheja. Valued at a portion of the income from the endowment, it will be awarded annually, on a rotational basis between the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Sciences and the Faculty of Business Administration. Normally, it will be presented during National Co-operative Education Week, to an engineering student who has completed work term 2 or 3, or a business student who has completed work term 2, in the previous fall semester. **Preference will be given to industrious students who have demonstrated an excellent work ethic.** The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for a scholarship as defined by Memorial University. The scholarship will be awarded by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards, on the recommendation of the Director of the Division of Co-operative Education, with a nomination from the student's employer.
