This scholarship was established by generous donations from members of the Memorial University of Newfoundland's Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science Class of 1975. Valued at a portion of the income on the endowment, it will be awarded annually to a student in any undergraduate program in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science who has completed an outstanding co-op work term, based on a nomination from their employer/supervisor. The recipient must have shown great leadership and initiative, and provided outstanding service to their organization. Preference will be given to a student who is completing their first or second required work term during the fall semester and who is continuing into the next academic term. The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for a scholarship as defined by the University. The scholarship will be awarded by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards on the recommendation of the Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science, in consultation with the Engineering Co-operative Education Office.
