

MSc and PhD Positions Available! (April 2020)

Two graduate research assistant positions are available for students who wish to pursue MSc or PhD degree in the Department of Earth Sciences at Memorial University of Newfoundland. The preferred start date is September 2020. The research assistants will conduct laboratory-based research to study the fate and transport of contaminants (especially engineered micro- and nanoparticles) in soil and groundwater environments. Some field work may be required. Candidates with a Bachelor's degree in earth sciences, soil science, hydrology, environmental engineering, hydraulics, chemistry, petroleum engineering, or other related fields are encouraged to apply. A master's degree is required for PhD program applicants.
