Year 4 (Month 6 -12)

- Examination of thesis (normally takes 1-2 months, could also take longer)
- Set time for thesis defense (arrange time with Grad secretary)
- Thesis defense (oral seminar followed by questions ~ 3 hours long)
- Thesis reports returned
- Correction of thesis (you have 6 month to make corrections)
- Submission of corrected thesis (with RAD form signed by your supervisor)
- Upload thesis to library via MUN Portal
