Bio: Georges Zaccour holds the Chair in Game Theory and Management and is a full professor at HEC Montréal's Department of Management Sciences. He holds a PhD in Management Science and a M.Sc. in International Business from HEC and a Licence in Mathematics and Economics from Université Paris-Dauphine.

Abstract: After recalling the main ingredients of international environmental agreements (IEAs), I recall some basic concepts of game theory. Next, I discuss how non-cooperative and cooperative game theory can help in understanding the huge difficulties of designing an operational and stable international agreement to tackle global environmental problems.
