



Memorial University of Newfoundland (Faculty of Education) and HarbourVOICES! International Festival of Collective Singing Traditions (June 29-July 4, 2024) are collaborating to offer an exciting graduate course as part of the 2024 MUN SINGING-CHORAL INSTITUTE - ED 6919/MUSIC7801: SINGING TRADITIONS AND PRACTICES.

This course focuses on singing traditions and practices (e.g., artistic, cultural, sociological, pedagogical, stylistic, historical, health, and well-being). It includes attendance at HarbourVOICES! presentations, workshops and concerts in addition to on-site seminars and additional course requirements via Memorial University Brightspace (3 credits).

ED 6919/MUSIC7801 runs May 7 - Aug 3, 2024 (Spring Semester 2024) in a blended format:

- online components (readings, postings) via Brightspace (May 7 June 26)
- on-site participation in the HarbourVOICES! International Festival of Collective Singing Traditions (June 29 July 4, 2024) will begin on the morning of June 28,
- Final projects/papers will be due and submitted online by August 3, 2024.

As a student in ED6919 you will have opportunities to attend and engage in presentations, workshops, round-table discussions, lecture-recitals, master classes, rehearsals, panel presentations, workshops, roundtable dialogues, concerts, and social and networking events...and earn graduate credit at the same time!

HOW TO REGISTER

(NB: this is a 2-part registration process – both with Memorial University AND HarbourVOICES! Festival)

PART I: HarbourVOICES! Festival

All students in the Singing-Choral Institute must register also for the <u>HarbourVOICES! International Festival</u> <u>of Collective Singing Traditions (June 29-July 4, 2024)</u> as a SOLO TOGETHER PARTICIPANT (i.e. individual) in the **student** category. PART II: Memorial University

1. If you are enrolled currently in a graduate program at Memorial University, the cost of course registration is included already in general fees (as an elective course in an approved program). If you are already enrolled in a MUN Graduate program, simply choose the course (ED6919) from the Spring Session Course offerings. You may need to obtain a waiver to be able to do this (i.e if you are not an M Ed or M Mus student). If that is the case, contact Tina Hunt at muneduc@mun.ca

2. If you are not enrolled currently in a graduate program at Memorial University or have not completed courses at MUN in the past three semesters, you will need to apply or reapply to MUN for general registration (**please note that an Undergraduate application needs to be used for this purpose**, even though it is a Graduate course):
