Students admitted with just one science academic discipline (teachable area) only register for Education 4174 (course and lab sections).

\*\* Students admitted with two Social Studies academic disciplines (teachable areas) must register for Education 4180 and Education 4181. (Social Studies disciplines include: Business Studies, Canadian Studies, Economics, Geography (Arts), History, Newfoundland Studies, and Political Science. Students admitted with just one Social Studies academic discipline (teachable) only register for Education 4180 (two sections available).

\*\*\* Students admitted with a Physical Education academic discipline (teachable area) must register for Education 4190 (course and lab sections).
