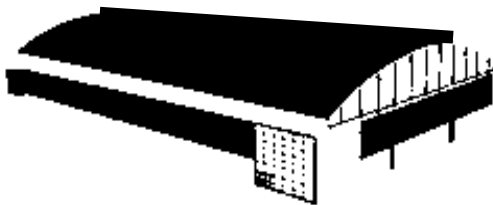
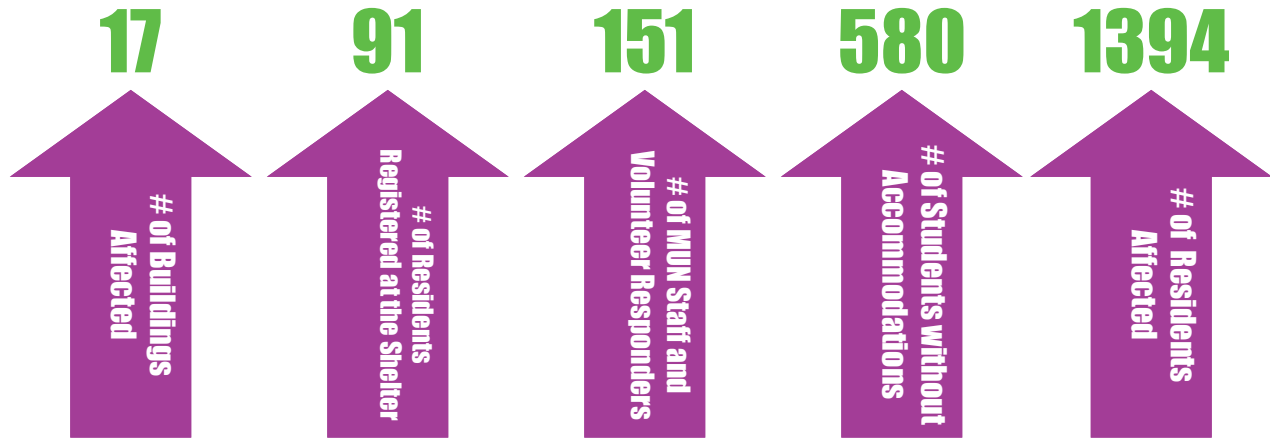


POWER OUTAGE

On February 29, 2012 a high voltage cable on the St. John's Campus of Memorial University failed. The event lasted until March 5, 2012.
