




TITLE: Associate Dean of Graduate Studies Bursary for Special Purposes (ADGS-SP)

STATUS: The Bursary will be awarded to a registered graduate student in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science. The number, value and focus of these scholarships will depend on the available funds, and will be determined on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the Associate Dean, Graduate Studies.

This bursary is established in 2017 by the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science to assist graduate students who are faced with unusual or exceptional circumstances which prevent the individual from moving forward in their graduate studies. The intention is to lighten an exceptional financial burden during a life crisis. Funding for this bursary will be provided by special fee revenues from engineering course-based graduate programs. The bursary will be issued to the student in the form of a fellowship and applied directly to the student's account at Memorial.

TERMS OF REFERENCE AND DESCRIPTION FOR APPROVAL:

This bursary will be awarded only under very exceptional circumstances, at most once per year, to a student enrolled in a graduate program in the Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science, Memorial University. The exceptional circumstances include, but are not limited to, life threatening medical issues or a serious accident causing life threatening injuries of oneself. The recipient must meet the requirements of satisfactory academic standing as defined by Memorial University of Newfoundland. The bursary will be used to assist engineering graduate students in grave financial hardship oneself who have exhausted all other possible means of support. The decision will be made based on a review of relevant evidence as well as the circumstances under the discretion of the Associate Dean, Graduate Studies, Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science.




