## GRAMMARLY PREMIUM INSTRUCTIONS

Grammarly is a powerful writing tool that helps make sure everything you type is easy to read, effective, and mistake-free. Grammarly's algorithms flag potential issues in the text and suggest context-specific corrections for grammar, spelling and usage, wordiness, style, punctuation, and even plagiarism. Grammarly explains the reasoning behind each correction, so you can make an informed decision about if correction is needed.

#### Microsoft Office Add-In

Although the Microsoft Office Add-In has now been officially sunset, it can still be downloaded at <https://www.grammarly.com/office-addin/downloading>. This implementation is no longer updated or supported, but it remains functional. It integrates into MS Office programs, such as Word and Outlook, to provide suggestions for writing. People who write long documents in Word or who use e-mail frequently might choose the add-in instead of the previous options.
