

Facilities Management Color Pallet Standard

1. Public area Colors (The Memorial Color Pallet)

Please select the paint color of your choice. NOTE: The Memorial Color, Memorial Black and Memorial Medium Grey are not to be used as a main wall color palette.



2. Office Wall Colors

* (laboratory and classroom colors to be reviewed and approved by Facilities Management) Please select paint color of your choice



3. Pop Colors

* (Designed to enhance large open areas, either inside offices or in public areas) Please select paint color of your choice. Use may require prior approval from Facilities Management. Pop colors are not approved for full offices, doors or frames.

4. Door Colors

The **public** side of doors/frames should match the adjacent corridor doors in the building. Where a new color is needed, it should be selected from **Public area colors** above. Direction on changing colors should be directed to Facilities, Engineering and Development. Some buildings may have an established door color scheme in place (which does not match the Public area colors above), in these cases colors can be repainted to match the current scheme, however if a building wide repainting is requested, a color is to be chosen from the Public area colors above.

Non-public side of doors/frames can be chosen from Public area colors above. Any changes to public area walls, doors/frames must be approved through Facilities, Engineering and Development.

NOTE: The exception to the above paint standard are main and accent color selections for Core Science Facility, Paton College and Burton's Pond Apartments. Contact Engineering & Construction for exact colors.
