



M.A. Opportunity in Religious Studies

Dr. Jennifer Selby is recruiting a graduate student to begin in September 2019 who is interested in undertaking research related to contemporary secularism in the North Atlantic region for a one-year project-based Master of Arts degree. Secondary language skills are an asset.

The Fellowship is valued at \$18,000 CAD per year. This funding includes \$12,000 of baseline funding and \$6,000 of graduate assistantship work. The student will also be encouraged/supported to attend one academic conference.

To qualify for funding, students must have held a 75% average in the last 20 courses of their latest degree. International students are welcome to apply. Tuition at MUN is the lowest in Canada outside of Quebec and St. John's is a uniquely beautiful place to live!
