The successful candidate will be familiar with current digital technologies, including 3d printing, laser and vinyl printing. A familiarity with more traditional tools (including woodworking, metalworking and textiles) would also be appropriate.

The successful candidate will report to the Director of the CRI and will assist in the day to day running of the makerspace, including maintaining and repairing equipment, as well as assisting users to complete a variety of tasks. Assisting users learn to use our tools is a vital part of our operation, and so the Assistant should also have good communication and interpersonal skills. The successful candidate will be energetic, dynamic and self-motivated, with a desire to foster a safe, inclusive, and welcoming “maker” community.

- Full-time undergraduate student
- 60% cumulative average /or/ 60% in last 10 courses completed
- Students may hold no more than one 80hr MUCEP position or two 40hr positions simultaneously
