

Edward P Browne Scholarship

This scholarship was established by individual members of faculty, staff, and student body of Grenfell Campus in memory of the late Edward P Browne. Professor Browne was Co-ordinator of Physical Education and Recreation at Grenfell Campus from its opening until his death in 1982. The scholarship is open to a full-time student who has spent at least two semesters at Grenfell Campus. It is awarded on the basis of academic standing, participation in college life, and may include financial need. The award will be made by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards on recommendation from the Grenfell Campus. The value of the award will be determined from the interest accrued on the principal sum donated.
