2026 Academic Bridging Application

Application Deadline: August 12th, 2026

Memorial University applicants (current or previous high graduates) who pass all 5 required subjects for admission, but miss Memorial's admission average by five per cent or less (65 – 69.9%), are eligible to apply to the Academic Bridging Program. This program is available to students attending any of Memorial's campuses. Upon successful completion of the Academic Bridging Program, students will have their admission at Memorial University verified.

The Academic Bridging Program is comprised of 3 key components:

1. **Complete Academic Prep Week** – A mandatory one-week, in-person intensive academic orientation program that will be held at Grenfell Campus in Corner Brook from August 31, 2026 - September 4, 2026 (cost \$337). Students must register through Memorial Self-Service (online portal) in the same way that they will register for Fall university courses.
2. **Register for UNIV 1010 in Fall 2026**– Students will be required to limit their course registration to 12 credit hours which must include University 1010, a credit course that provides students with tools and techniques that can lead to academic success. UNIV 1010 will be offered in-person at Grenfell Campus in the Fall semester and remotely for students attending another Memorial University Campus.
3. **Meet with your Academic Advisor** – Academic Bridging students must attend mandatory advising sessions in September (during Academic Prep Week), September (prior to the last day to drop a course with 100% tuition refund), and October (prior to the start of registration for the January semester).
4. **Obtain a minimum semester average of 50% in your first semester** – To receive verified admission to Memorial University, in addition to meeting the above requirements, you must obtain a minimum semester average of 50%.
