Doctor's Surgery

You can book an appointment to see a doctor at Jenner House, Garden Terrace road, Old Harlow; telephone 01279 418136. You will be charged for the appointment (around £40) if you do not have a working visa.

Chemist/Drug Store

Ramco in the High Street is open Monday to Friday 09.00-18.30; Saturday 09.00-17.30. Tel No. 01279 423911 A Pharmacist is always available for advice, over the counter drugs, this is also where you can collect your prescriptions.

Dentist

The minimum charge is approximately £30.00 each consultation.

Visitors to the UK from non-EEC countries will normally be charged for medical and dental treatment, whether in hospital, Doctors or Dentist surgery. Newfoundland residents are covered in accordance with MCP fee scale and will be reimbursed for any doctor's fees occurred whilst in Britain upon return home. You must make sure you collect a receipt or the appropriate form completed by Doctor or Dentist.

Visitors must also pay for prescription drugs, current charge £8.80 each item (August 2018).
