- Need for economic diversification




# K-12 Enrolment, Zone 6 & 7 2000-01 to 2005-06




# The role of universities in regional development

- Universities are a resource which is available to the entire community.



#### The Labrador Institute

- Is the main contact point for the University in Labrador.
- Maintains communications with aboriginal and community groups.
- Sponsors many cultural activities including the Labrador Creative Arts Festival.
- Facilitates and coordinates the activity of personnel at the University as they undertake cultural, research and educational activities.



#### **Marine Institute**

- 34 projects conducted in 2005-06 in rural Newfoundland and Labrador:
