- **PUT ON ADDITIONAL PPE, IF REQUIRED, AS PER MSDS**
- **IF SPILL IS COMBUSTIBLE, REMOVE SOURCES OF IGNITION**
- **CLEAN-UP CONTAINED SPILL MATERIAL, DISPOSE OF AS HAZARDOUS WASTE**
- **COMPLETE FINAL REPORTING: SUBMIT HAZARDOUS WASTE AND INCIDENT REPORTS TO DHS**

above questions and have any doubts
about your safety or that of others in
the area:

- **SOUND THE BUILDING ALARM (Fire Alarm Pull Station) AND CALL FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE (numbers listed below)**
- **EVACUATE THE AREA, MOVE 100 METERS (300 ft) TO DESIGNATED ASSEMBLY POINT**
- **ADMINISTER FIRST AID OR SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION, AS REQUIRED**
- **NOTIFY YOUR SUPERVISOR**
- **DO NOT ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL TOLD BY FIRE DEPARTMENT / CEP**
- **SUBMIT INCIDENT REPORT FORM TO DHS**
