

SNOW BLOWER SAFE OPERATION:

Snow is a part of life in the winter. Following simple safety rules while operating a snow blower will help ensure everyone's safety.

- Make sure children and pets are indoors before you start snow blowing.
- Operate only with proper guards or other protective devices in place.
- Always allow unit and engine time to adjust to outdoor temperatures.
- Keep snow blower's cutting edge tilted slightly up during first pass. Doing this helps prevent contact with foreign objects that may be in your driveway.
- Stay alert for traffic, pedestrians or other hazards. If someone approaches you, immediately power down the snow blower.
- Keep movement on slopes slow and gradual.
- Disengage the attachment drive while moving from one area to another.
- Direct the plume of snow away from buildings, vehicles and people. Plan snow clearing patterns to take advantage of prevailing winds. Snow blowing will be more efficient and visibility greatly enhanced when snow blowing with the wind.
