- Hiring Update: Negotiations are complete for our successful Indigenous Cluster hire candidate, and the appointment is in the last stages of being finalized. Dr. Daria Boltokova will be joining the Anthropology Department in January of 2022. The Provost has approved a recommendation for a tenure-track spousal appointment for Dr. Sean Gray, who was interviewed and strongly endorsed by the Department of Political Science. Dr. Gray starts in July 2022. Following consultation with the Heads, the position that HSS was approved to recruit for has been allocated to Economics in the area of applied econometrics.
- Dean's Office HR: The Intermediate Secretary position in the Dean's Office has been posted and interviews will be completed over the next few days. Suzanne Browne is welcomed to the Dean's Office. Suzanne will be working on finance in HSS.
- Strategic Planning for HSS: The university has passed a new strategic plan "Transforming our Horizons" and all faculties are tasked with implementing that plan, in part through creating/revising strategic plans at the faculty level that align with the five strategic themes of the University plan. HSS (along with all other faculties and schools) is expected to have a strategic plan in place by the end of the Winter semester.
