

Dr. Paul O’Neill Scholarship for Excellence in NL Studies

Application Form

The Historic Sites Association of Newfoundland and Labrador established this Scholarship in honour of Dr. Paul O’Neill, LL.D., C.M., in recognition of his contributions to the study and promotion of Newfoundland and Labrador culture and history. Valued at \$1,000, the Scholarship will be awarded biennially to an undergraduate student in any year of study in the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at Memorial University of Newfoundland. To be eligible, students must submit completed coursework as part of an application to demonstrate excellence and outstanding enthusiasm and interest in some area of Newfoundland Studies as part of their degree studies. The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for scholarship standing as defined by the University. The Scholarship will be awarded by the Senate Committee on Undergraduate Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards on the recommendation of the Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. An application is required.
