Research Fellowships: Starting Summer/Fall 2021

The Department of Economics invites applications for Four (4) Research Fellowships positions, funded by SSHRC and SGS, for the Summer/Fall 2021 semester. The position will entail 15 hours per week of research support for Dr. Tony Fang, Stephen Jarislowsky Chair in Cultural and Economic Transformation.

Qualifications:

- Registered full time students in any discipline, who must normally have successfully completed at least one full semester of graduate studies and achieved a mark of at least 75% in each program course attempted or an overall average of at least 80% for all program courses.
- The student will also work on the Master's thesis/essay under Dr. Fang's supervision, on the topic related to the missions of the Jarislowsky Chair, such as immigration, labour market, productivity, and entrepreneurship.
- The successful applicant should be able to work independently and require minimal instruction.

Duties:

- Conduct literature review and data analysis using STATA/SPSS for various research projects related to the recruitment, retention and labor market integration of recent immigrants to Canada and Newfoundland and Labrador;
- Assist the Chair with applications for research funding from SSHRC and Federal and Provincial government and other sources
