

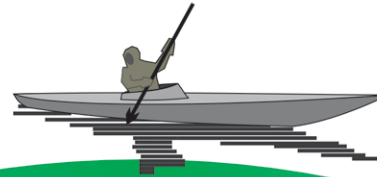

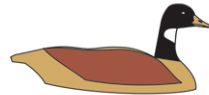

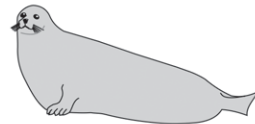

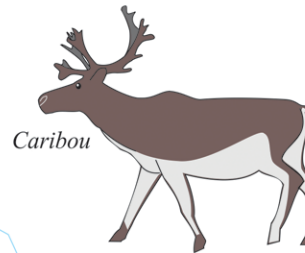


Part of French sword hilt, found in 18th century Inuit winter house in Sandwich Bay.
