PREREQUISITE

Successful completion of French 1502 with an overall grade of 65% or special permission granted by the Head of Department.

WHY APPLY?

- Fulfil degree requirements while experiencing French culture first hand in France's unique archipelago.
- Meet new people & build new friendships with fellow French Studies students at Memorial.

SPRING PROGRAM



This is a 4 week-long program from **May 22nd to June 19th** during which students will live with a local host family and take two MUN courses at an accelerated pace: French 2300 and French 2900.

PROGRAM COST

MUN tuition for 2 courses and associated fees + a \$1,500 program fee to cover room & board, transportation costs, textbooks as well as extracurricular activities. Travel insurance is not included in the program fee.

FALL PROGRAM

This is a semester-long program that runs from **Sept. 8th to Dec. 6th**. During their stay, students will live with a local host family and take five MUN courses: French 2100, French 2101, French 2300, French 2900, and French 2602.

PROGRAM COST

MUN tuition for 5 courses and associated fees + a \$2,000 program fee to cover room & board, transportation costs, textbooks as well as extracurricular activities. Travel insurance is not included in the program fee.
