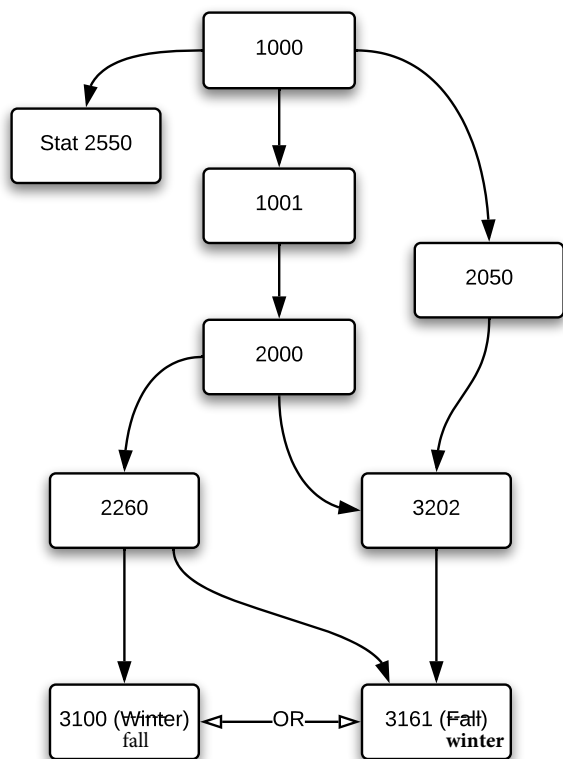


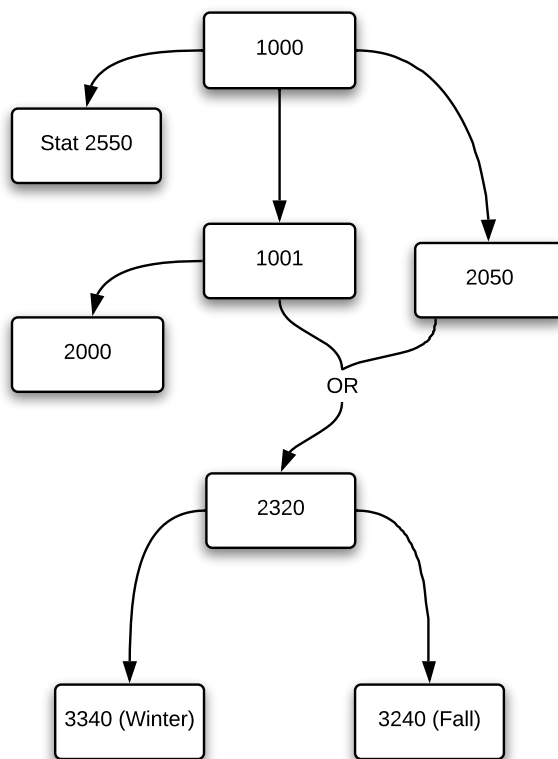

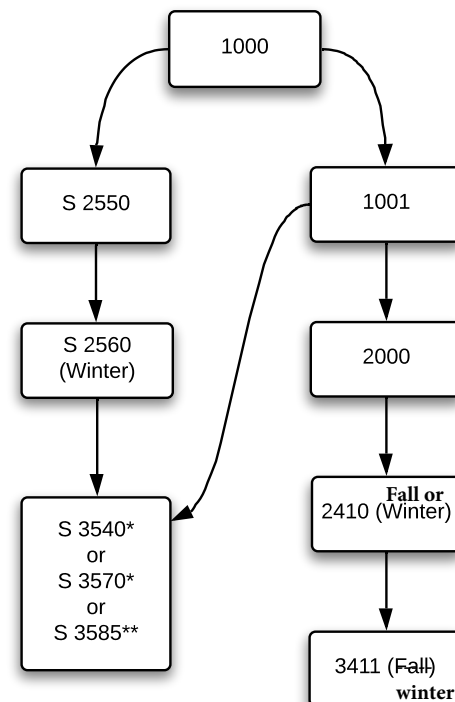
Suggestion 1: Focus on Differential Equations

The above outlines are merely suggestions. Many more combinations of courses will satisfy the requirements for the Minor in Mathematics: Eight MATH and/or STAT courses, of which at least two have the first digit 3 or 4, and of which no more than two have the first digit 1.

Students may consult Previous Course Offerings to find out when a course is usually offered. Confirmation of the upcoming academic year course offerings is usually available mid-June.

** Stat 3585 requires Stat 2560 and Math 2000.

***A Minor in Mathematics with a focus on probability and statistics is not the same as the Minor in Statistics. Students interested in the Minor in Statistics should consult the Deputy Head (Statistics).
