***RAPID FIRE QUESTIONS IN THROMBOSIS AND ANTICOAGULATION**

From a VTE perspective, is my patient safe to fly?	If my patient has Afib and they develop an intracranial or GI bleed, should I restart anticoagulation afterward to prevent a stroke?
Should superficial vein thrombosis be treated with NSAIDs alone or is there a role for anticoagulants?	My patient is going for a dental procedure , what should I do with their anticoagulation ?
Should I order a follow up USS to see if the clot is gone?	Which drugs or herbal medications are contraindicated /should be avoided while on various anticoagulants?
If the clot is gone on a follow up ultrasound or CTPA, can I stop anticoagulation ?	What should a patient do if they miss a dose of their anticoagulant?
Can my patient ever receive estrogen containing therapy again after a hormonal associated VTE?	Do graduated compression stockings prevent post-thrombotic syndrome in patients with DVT?

How do I switch between anticoagulants ?	Does the presence of an inherited thrombophilia mean that a patient should be on lifelong anticoagulation therapy ?
How do I advise on alcohol and foods for patients on anticoagulation ?	Which anticoagulant should I use in renal failure and how often should I check the renal function?
My patient with atrial fibrillation is frail and has a high risk of falls, should they be anticoagulated?	Should I prescribe below knee or above knee stockings to treat patients with post-thrombotic syndrome ? Can the sock be worn only on the affected leg?
Should I treat a below knee DVT ?	How soon after an episode of pulmonary embolism or proximal DVT can my patient exercise and go back to work?
Management of abnormal uterine bleeding on anticoagulation therapy	How can I get coverage of the DOAC's?
