#### **\*RAPID FIRE QUESTIONS IN THROMBOSIS AND ANTICOAGULATION**

From a VTE perspective, <b>is my patient safe to fly?</b>	If my patient has Afib and they develop an <b>intracranial or GI bleed, should I restart anticoagulation</b> afterward to prevent a stroke?
<b>Should superficial vein thrombosis be treated</b> with NSAIDs alone or is there a role for anticoagulants?	My patient is going for a <b>dental procedure</b> , what should I do with their <b>anticoagulation</b> ?
<b>Should I order a follow up USS</b> to see if the clot is gone?	Which <b>drugs or herbal medications are</b> <b>contraindicated</b> /should be avoided while on various <b>anticoagulants?</b>
<b>If the clot is gone</b> on a follow up ultrasound or CTPA, <b>can I stop anticoagulation</b> ?	What should a patient do if they miss a dose of their anticoagulant?
Can my patient ever receive estrogen containing therapy again after a hormonal associated VTE?	Do graduated <b>compression stockings prevent</b> <b>post-thrombotic syndrome</b> in patients with DVT?

How do I <b>switch between anticoagulants</b> ?	Does the presence of an <b>inherited thrombophilia</b> mean that a patient should be on <b>lifelong</b> <b>anticoagulation therapy</b> ?
How do I advise on <b>alcohol and foods</b> for patients on <b>anticoagulation</b> ?	Which anticoagulant should I use in renal failure and how often should I check the renal function?
My patient with atrial fibrillation is frail and has a high risk of falls, should they be anticoagulated?	Should I prescribe <b>below knee or above knee</b> <b>stockings to treat</b> patients with <b>post-thrombotic</b> <b>syndrome</b> ? Can the sock be worn only on the affected leg?
Should I <b>treat a below knee DVT</b> ?	How soon after an episode of pulmonary embolism or proximal DVT can my patient exercise and go back to work?
Management of abnormal <b>uterine bleeding on</b> anticoagulation therapy	How can I get coverage of the DOAC's?
