Overview:

Assessment within the Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) program is designed to ensure that medical learners have the knowledge base and clinical skills required to transition into clinical practice at the end of the program. All medical learners must meet the requirements detailed in the assessment plans which are set in consultation with the Student Assessment Subcommittee and the appropriate Phase Management Team.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Attend Phase 4 Management Team meetings
- Serve as the Phase 4 faculty representative on the Student Assessment subcommittee (SAS), which involves:
 - o attending monthly SAS meetings (September to June)
 - o reporting to SAS on matters of Phase 4 assessment
- Review Phase 4 assessment plans
- Work with Phase Management to set comprehensive clinical science exam schedule
