Overview:

The Physician Competencies Course runs throughout all four (4) Phases of the M.D. Program and provides students with opportunities to advance their non-medical expert roles.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Attend monthly Phase 1, 2, 3 and 4 Management team meetings and Curriculum Oversight Working Group meetings, as needed.
- Oversee the delivery of learning materials and assessments associated with the Physician Competencies Courses (MED 5730, 6770, 7730 and 8750)
 - Leadership
 - Research
- Correspond with learners regarding course delivery, assessments, and reassessments.
- Attend the Research Days for each of the 4 Phases
 - back-up for research day assessors who are unable to attend

Operations

- The Physician Competencies Lead is selected by the Curriculum Lead, in consultation with the Associate Dean, UGME, subsequent to an Expression of Interest.
- Administrative support is provided by the Office of UGME
