

NLMA Leadership Scholarship Application Form



Background Information

Funded by the Newfoundland & Labrador Medical Association (NLMA) through its charity the Physicians' Legacy Foundation, one scholarship valued at \$1,000 will be granted annually in recognition of the NLMA's mission to "represent and support a united medical profession and provide leadership in the provision of excellent health care in Newfoundland and Labrador".

This scholarship will be awarded annually to a student from Newfoundland and Labrador entering the doctor of medicine degree program at Memorial University of Newfoundland. Eligible students must be members of the NLMA. Recipients will have demonstrated leadership and community engagement, and must meet the minimum academic requirements for a scholarship as defined by the University.

This scholarship is renewable for each year of the four-year program provided that recipients demonstrate continued leadership and community engagement by submitting an application with a brief description of their ongoing activities.

Requirements

Applicants must:

1. Be a student entering the Undergraduate Medical Education Program.
2. Be from Newfoundland and Labrador.
3. Be a member of the NLMA.
4. Meet scholarship standing as defined by the university.
5. Submit a current CV.
6. Complete this application form.
7. Submit all documents by email to ScholarshipsUGME@mun.ca.

Application forms must be signed and completed in full by the applicant. Incomplete or improperly prepared application forms disqualify the applicant from the competition.
