Orlo trained in Medical Laboratory Technology in PEI and furthered her studies at the Douglass College of Rutgers University with a Bachelor of Science degree. She worked and taught in the field of laboratory technology in Canada and the United States. In 1964, she returned to PEI and taught in Summerside schools. Orlo was also well-known for her expertise in the field of genealogy, particularly Loyalist history.

- 5. Optional: Submit a <u>bursary application form</u> to state your financial need. Please note, preference will be given to students who have demonstrated financial need.
- 6. Complete this application form.
